





Adventure Hike Käfertal

Scenic landscape framed by peaks over three thousand meters high

Level of difficulty: Easy summer excursion on wide hiking trails

Equipment: Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate

clothing and spare clothing, backpack with drinks and snacks;

Costs: €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (7-16 years old) accompanied by

their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!

Dogs: The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration

or other participants and local wildlife.

Meeting point: Every Wednesday (from July 10, 2024, to September 4, 2024) at 9:15 a.m. in

Ferleiten at the parking lot of Tauernahaus (47.16939; 12.81139).

How to reach us: From Bruck an der Glocknerstraße, take the B107 through Fusch to Ferleiten

Duration:Approximately 3,5 hours.Pure walking time:Approximately 2,5 hours.Route:Approximately 8 kilometers.

Ascent: Approximately 130 meters in altitude. **Refreshment stops**: Possibility for refreshments after the tour.

Booking: No registration required – come to the specified meeting point at the given

time; our ranger will wait for the bus and then start punctually.

Description: The tour begins at the ticket counter of Wildpark Ferleiten. Passing by Tauernhaus Ferleiten, the hike follows a well-developed forest path into the beautifully situated Käfertal. Below the 'Großes Wiesbachhorn' and its impressive glacier world, around 300 beetle and almost 200 large butterfly species thrive. On this adventure trail, nature enthusiasts of all ages can discover the inhabitants of alpine meadows and pastures. The conclusion includes a Kneipp facility and a water playground for the little ones. The return journey follows the same route.
