




Hike to the Source of the Mur River

To the source of a european river

Level of difficulty:	Moderate summer excursion on well-developed paths with a destination above the valley floor; hiking or mountain shoes with a treaded sole required.
Equipment:	Hiking or mountain shoes with a treaded sole, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
Costs:	€22 for adults. Children and adolescents (10-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
Dogs:	The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration or other participants and local wildlife.
Meeting point:	Every Thursday (from July 11, 2024, to September 5, 2024) at 09:00 AM at the Muritzen parking lot. (47.13321, 13.40251)
How to reach us:	By car to the Muritzen parking lot (fee required, the machine only accepts coins – please have change with you!)
Duration: Pure walking time: Route: Ascent: Refreshment stops:	Approximately 5 hours. Approximately 4 hours. Approximately 12 kilometers. Approximately 300 meters in altitude. Possibility for refreshments after the tour.
Booking	No registration required – come to the specified location at the designated time. Our ranger will meet the bus and start promptly afterward.

Description: The tour starts at the Muritzen parking lot, from where the hike leads upstream past marshy meadows. The small Mur Creek meanders through the U-shaped valley. Passing the Sticklerhütte, the tour follows the still small creek, which later swells into the second-longest river in Austria. Upon reaching the source, the hike turns back. The return journey follows the same route.
