

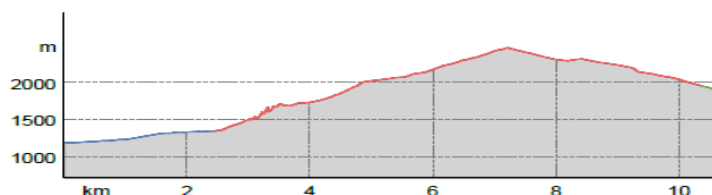
Korntauern

From Anlaufstal to Mallnitz

- Level of difficulty:** Special tour that requires good physical condition and surefootedness.
- Equipment:** Backpack, sun protection, ankle-high hiking boots, drink and snack, change of clothes, hat and gloves, possibly trekking poles.
- Costs:** €40; plus cable car, bus, and train fees.
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** August 24, 2024; at 7:00 AM at the Anlaufstal parking lot (47.07607157732603, 13.137275798732857).
- How to reach us:** Take the exit at Lend onto the B167 Gasteiner Straße and follow it until you reach Böckstein. At Böckstein, turn towards Tauernschleuse and follow the access road, passing by the lock station. Before the bridge, there is a parking lot on the right.
- Participants:** Minimum 3 people, maximum 8 people
- Duration:** Approximately 9 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 6,5 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 11 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 1360 meters in altitude.
- Descent:** Approximately 615 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** Refreshment possible after the tour.

Description: In the morning, we meet at the parking lot in Anlaufstal. From there, we hike through the narrow and steep Anlaufstal. At the head of the valley, the Ankogel mountain dominates the scenery. Before reaching the Tauernbachfall, we cross the Anlaufbach and begin the ascent towards Korntauern. On the opposite side of the valley, we catch sight of the imposing Hölltorgrat. During the ascent, there is an opportunity to refill water bottles at a spring. The Roman road is still visible at certain points. The ranger provides intriguing information about the historical Tauern crossings. Descending from Korntauern, we reach the midstation of the Ankogelbahn and take the cable car down to the valley. Using the bus, we return to the starting point of the tour.
