





Pfandlscharte

Transalpine crossing with the ascent of a peak above 3000 meters

Level of difficulty: Special tour that requires good physical condition and surefootedness.

Equipment: Backpack, sun protection, ankle-high hiking boots, drink and snack, change of

clothes, hat and gloves, possibly trekking poles.

Costs: €40; plus taxi costs.

Dogs: The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration

for other participants and local wildlife.

Meeting point: August 10, 2024; at 6:00 AM at the Tauernhaus Ferleiten parking lot

(47.16939; 12.81139).

How to reach us: From Bruck an der Glocknerstraße, take the B107 through Fusch to Ferleiten,

to the Tauernhaus parking lot (47.16939; 12.81139).

Participants: Minimum of 3 people, maximum 7 people

Duration:Approximately 8 hours.Pure walking time:Approximately 6 hours.Route:Approximately 11 kilometers.

Ascent: Approximately 1000 meters in altitude.

Descent: Approximately 1590 meters in altitude.

Refreshment stops: Refreshment possible after the tour.

Description: Early in the morning, we will meet at the parking lot in Ferleiten. From here, we will drive along the Grossglockner High Alpine Road to the Glocknerhaus on the Carinthian side of the High Tauern. Passing Pfandlschartensee, we will ascend to the col, gaining 600 meters in elevation. The challenging climb is rewarded with a breathtaking view of the surrounding 3000-meter peaks of the Glockner group. From here, there is an option to ascend the somewhat exposed trail to the 3029-meter high Spielmann. Descending through Pfandlböden, we will reach Trauneralm. A visit here is a great opportunity to rest and replenish. For the return to the Ferleiten parking lot, we will arrange transportation via taxi.
