## Bellowing in the twilight

Level of difficulty:	We will embark on a light autumn excursion along well-maintained paths, with observation points located near the traveled road.
Equipment:	Hiking boots with treaded soles, rain protection, appropriate clothing, hat and gloves, backpack with drinks and snacks; optionally binoculars.
Costs:	€22. Children and teenagers accompanied by their parents go free. Free with the guest card or National Park Summer Card!
Dogs:	The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration or other participants and local wildlife.
Meeting point:	On Thursday, September 19, 2024, at 6:00 PM and Thursday, September 26, 2024, at 5:30 PM in front of the National Park Exhibition "im Facettenreich"; Dorfstraße 27, 5661 Rauris (47.19597, 12.97576)
How to reach us:	Drive on the B311 towards Rauris. The Dorfstraße, where the exhibition is located, is in the center of Rauris and is well signposted. Dorfstraße 27, 5661 Rauris (47.19597, 12.97576)

**Description:** The meeting point is at the National Park Exhibition in the district of Wörth. From there, we will carpool in our vehicles to the Hüttwinkltal towards Alpengasthof Bodenhaus.

At certain points, there will be opportunities to observe the red deer during their rutting behavior undisturbed. The roaring of the stags is always clearly audible, accompanying us from dusk until darkness falls when the last light of the day fades away.

If the animals are not directly visible to the naked eye, we will utilize optical aids such as binoculars and scopes. The behavior of these impressive mammals throughout the seasons is also a significant topic for us.
